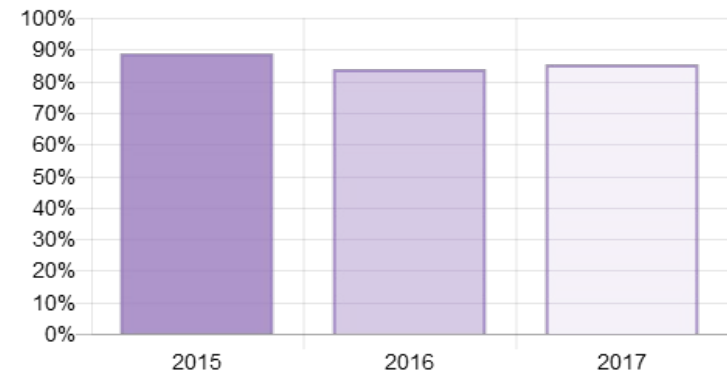

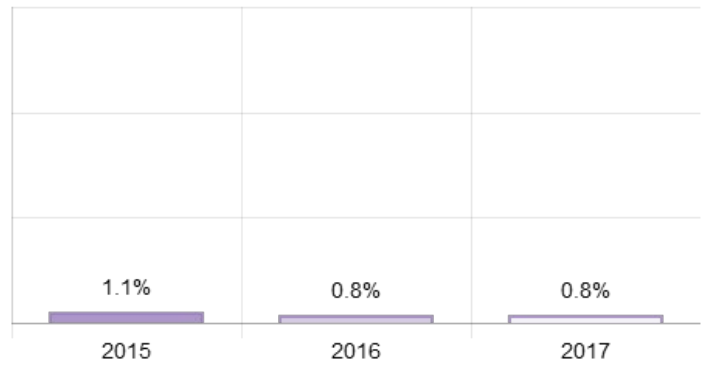
#### English Learner Progress Indicator (Grades K-12)

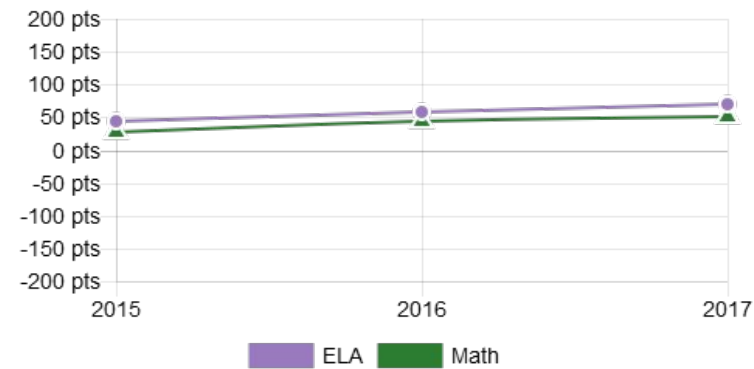
