Not while stay at home orders are in place. Not likely after they are lifted, but it depends on the Covid numbers.</li> </ul> </li>   <li>• ELL Updates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Shull ELD Small EL population at Shull. Our aide is Denise Atallah, she works with small groups and adds extra help to students.</li>   <li>○ RFEP - Redesignated English Fluent Proficient All EL students are tested when entering school. They take the LPAC, but with Covid, last year was incomplete. Students have gone in this year to complete it. Some students score out of EL and are redesignated as English fluent (RFEP). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Future EL testing Contingent on Covid numbers. We are supposed to do state testing and LPAC, but we don't know if this is a reality.
